

It was a book just like that, but it has been lost (maybe the cat took it): this book here remains and maybe Mum will like it anyway!



Perhaps, indeed, this is what writers are for, finding the words to defeat, if not death, then the loneliness of death and its repudiation, the hesitation and even the repugnance that those who suffer a loss arouse in others.

"The Missing Piece" by Pierdomenico Baccalario does this: it narrates the loss suffered by Vittorio and his pain for his brother Federico, in a coma after an accident. Vittorio tries to be him, and therefore to complete his comic collections, to walk in his footsteps, to exist in his role-playing games. When the writer narrates this, he doesn't just give life to a literary project, but to a project of reconstruction of what we have lost, not just who. It's the ability to share, even pain. "The Missing Piece" is not a book for young adults, but a novel for adults: because perhaps we should say enough to models and barriers and boxes, when stories manage to touch readers whatever their age or presumable taste. And this is why I am nominating this book for the 2024 Strega Prize."

It is at this point that her brother, Nicolas, comes to her with a story told to him by Christian, a guy he met one night at a disco. The story revolves around Christian's hometown, Vulcri, located in the Calanchi Valley, perched on a hill and connected to the mainland by a suspended bridge over a chasm. In this town, its inhabitants suddenly fall asleep. That's enough for Baladine to sense the presence of darkness and decide to go there.
